Photosexual

Photomancer

The photomancer's eye is a kind of mirror – sometimes called a lens of light. The way that its images blend into the environment is to provide some spatial coherence with light, while at the same time creating some contrast in a specific area. In some cases, the light reflects off objects in the same way so as to create two "blending" images. Photomancing is the ability to easily identify and recognize any small imperfections such as a crevice, tear, crevice size and color.
